



# Here Comes Treble!

A crocheted cowl you can wear 3 ways.



## *This is Crocheted with...*

|                              |  |
|------------------------------|--|
| <b>Yarn</b>                  | <b>Brown Sheep Burllyspun</b><br>1 skein (226g/ 121m)        |
| <b>Needles &amp; Notions</b> | 10-12mm hook, depending on your tension.<br>Darning needle.  |
| <b>Gauge</b>                 | 4" = 6 treble stitches but gauge is not essential            |
| <b>Measurements</b>          | Finished item = 20" x 8"; it will stretch a little with wear |

This pattern is written with UK stitch names.

A mega-quick project with sensational results! Wear your delicious new cowl draped loosely, wrapped tightly twice around your neck for those colder days, or horizontally across the shoulders for a cosier evening out.

## **INSTRUCTIONS:**

1. Chain 57 for foundation row.
2. Treble into third chain from hook on foundation row.
3. Work over and back in treble stitch for 4 rows.
4. Join for working in the round, and continue to work in the round for another four rounds, or to desired width.
5. Cast off, weave in ends and wear with pride!
